

Supporting information 2. Complete, sorted relevé and synoptic table.

The left part of the table contains the 67 10-m² relevés with percentage cover values shown with the respective Braun-Blanquet symbols (+: -2%, 1: -5%, 2: -25% etc.). The right part contains the synthetic columns of all relevés, the three orders and the 10 associations, first with percentage constancies, then with phi values standardised to the same number of plots in each syntaxon of the respective rank.

In the second column, the three main taxonomic groups are indicated (V: vascular plant; B: bryophyte; L: lichen). Diagnostic species are arranged by decreasing phi values in the respective syntaxon, other species by decreasing constancy in the whole dataset.

If an aggregate was only partly determined at species level or a species only partly at subspecies level, the syntaxonomic assessment was made at the higher taxonomic level, while the corresponding segregates are inserted below in italics, starting with "#".

Shading and boxes indicate the diagnostic values: light grey are diagnostic species of orders, dark grey diagnostic species of associations, while a frame indicates differential species or associations that are diagnostic for another order.

For phi-values the following colour codes are used: ≥ 0.50 : dark green; ≥ 0.25 : light green; ≥ 0.00 : yellow; < 0.00 : white.
